Approx. 100mm (4"). The product is mown before despatch to minimise damage to plants. It will not be in flower when it is delivered.

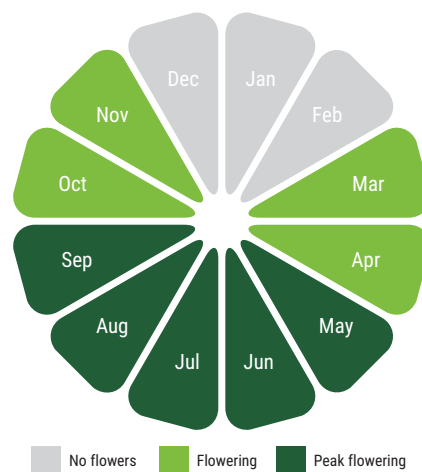

- **GROWTH** Turfonline Floral Focus Meadowmat® is a blend of 34 British native wild flowers and 6 naturalised flowers specially selected to be pollinator friendly and beautiful. Many of the species are perennial and will flower every year if the conditions are suitable. Grown on a biodegradable coir blanket, grass species are not necessary in this more colourful Meadowmat® which is also suitable for green roof installations. Floral Focus Meadowmat® will contain mature plants, root fibre and enough substrate to maintain the plant during establishment.

- **TYPICAL SEED MIXTURE*** 100% Native and Naturalised Wildflowers
- **SOIL CLASSIFICATION** Grown on bespoke extensive substrate.

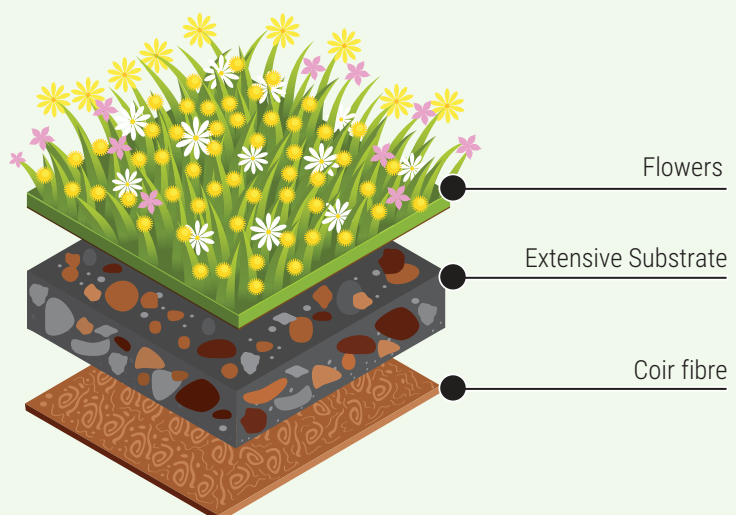
